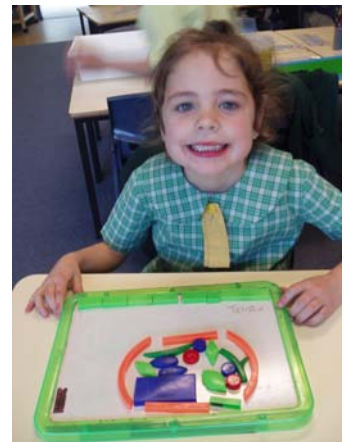
Watch HPS Junior Journos on NBN
