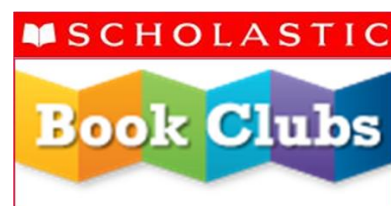
Warners Bay Cardiff Junior Cricket Club 2012-13 Season
