Yesterday we were very proud to celebrate one of our Kindergarten students, Myles Wellham who received an award from the NSW Ambulance Service. Last year when his mum collapsed at home Myles came to her rescue by dialing Triple Zero (000) and asking for an ambulance. Myles was able to give all the important information to the Ambulance call taker including his address and phone number. At our school assembly in front of a large crowd that included several reporters, Myles was given a Star Award and a very cute 'paramedic in training' teddy. The ambulance officers commended Myles' quick thinking and bravery and particularly recommended the 'Triple Zero Kids' Challenge', a free app that Myles had played, learning what to do in an emergency and which in the end helped him save his mum.

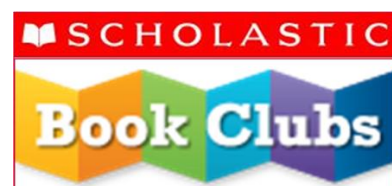

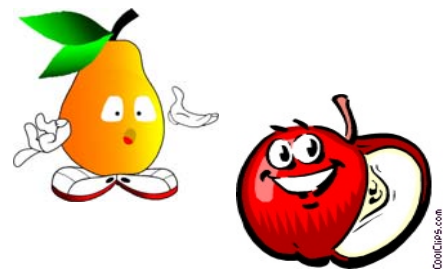
