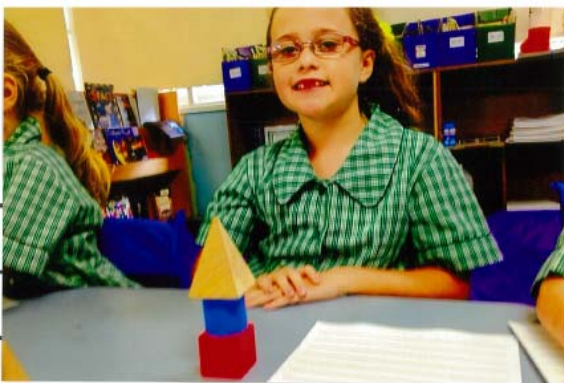


The lorax

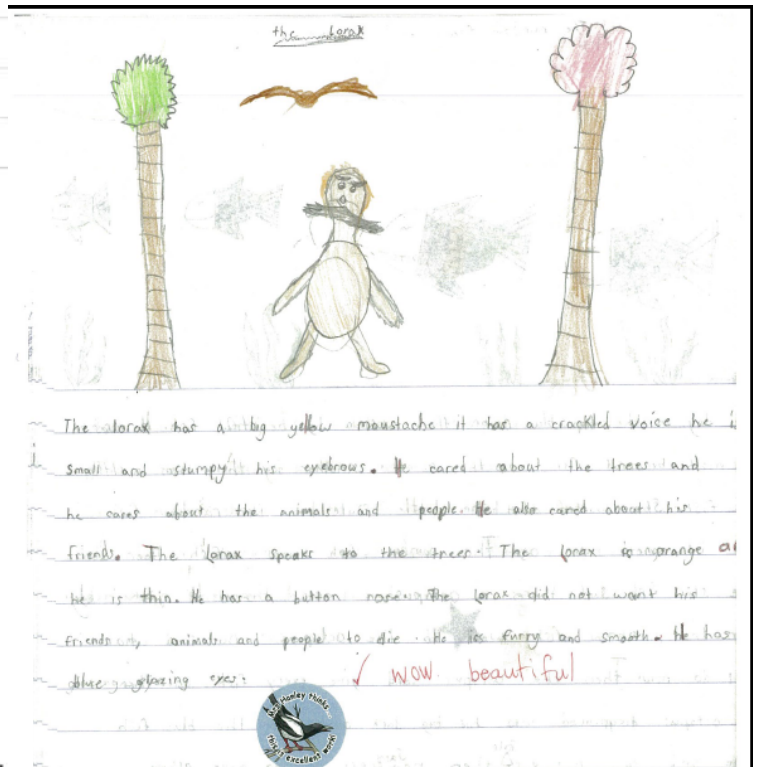

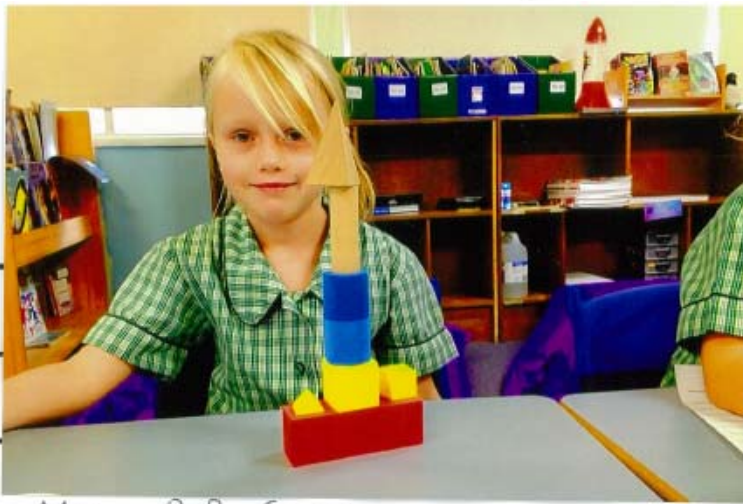

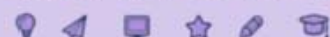


# P&C NEWS
