The next P&C meeting will be Friday 7 August 2015 8.30am in the Library.

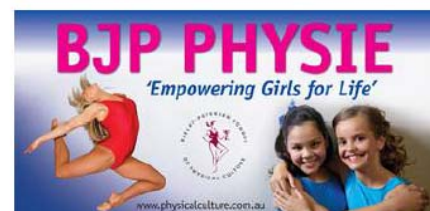
